

■ 1. Bar Equipment & Tools

Word / Phrase	A2 Definition
Shaker	A metal container used to mix drinks.
Strainer	A tool to remove ice or fruit pieces from a drink.
Jigger	A small cup to measure alcohol.
Muddler	A stick used to crush fruits or herbs in a glass.
Bar spoon	A long spoon for stirring drinks.
Ice bucket	A container for holding ice.
Tongs	A tool for picking up ice cubes.
Cocktail shaker	Another name for shaker.
Blender	A machine for mixing and crushing drinks.
Mixing glass	A glass used to mix drinks before serving.
Pourer	A small spout on a bottle to pour smoothly.
Corkscrew	A tool to open wine bottles.
Bottle opener	A tool to open beer bottles.
Ice scoop	A small shovel to take ice.
Coaster	A small mat to put under a glass.
Napkin	A small cloth or paper to clean hands or place under a drink.
Tray	A flat plate used to carry drinks.
Bar mat	A rubber mat to keep the bar clean and dry.
Chopping board	A board to cut fruits.
Knife	A tool to cut.

■ 2. Types of Glasses

Word / Phrase	A2 Definition
Wine glass	A glass for wine.
Champagne flute	A tall thin glass for champagne.
Martini glass	A wide glass for cocktails like martini.
Highball glass	A tall glass for mixed drinks.
Old fashioned glass	A short glass for whiskey.
Shot glass	A small glass for strong alcohol.
Beer mug	A large glass with a handle for beer.
Pint glass	A tall beer glass.
Cocktail glass	Any glass for cocktails.
Water glass	A normal glass for water.

Word / Phrase	A2 Definition
Beer	A drink made from barley and hops.
Wine	A drink made from grapes.

Whiskey	Strong alcohol made from grains.
Vodka	Clear strong alcohol from potatoes or grains.
Rum	Alcohol made from sugar cane.
Gin	Alcohol flavored with juniper.
Tequila	Alcohol made from agave.
Brandy	Strong alcohol made from wine.
Cognac	A special type of brandy from France.
Liqueur	Sweet flavored alcohol.

Word / Phrase	A2 Definition
Juice	Drink made from fruit.
Soda	Sweet fizzy drink.
Tonic water	Bitter fizzy water used with gin.
Sparkling water	Fizzy water.
Still water	Water without gas.
Lemonade	Sweet lemon drink.
Cola	Brown sweet fizzy drink.
Ginger ale	Sweet ginger-flavored drink.
Mocktail	Cocktail without alcohol.
Coffee	Hot drink made from coffee beans.

Lemon	Yellow sour fruit.
Lime	Green sour fruit.

Syrup	Thick sweet liquid.
Honey	Sweet food made by bees.
Cherry	Small red fruit often used for decoration.
Olive	Small green or black fruit for martinis.

Hygiene	Keeping things clean and safe.
Sanitize	Clean with special liquid.
Wash	Clean with water and soap.
Gloves	Plastic or cloth hand covers.
Apron	Cloth worn to protect clothes.

Mop	Tool for cleaning wet floors.
Trash bin	Container for garbage.
Fire extinguisher	Tool to stop a fire.
